Paper, Magazines, Newspapers

Cardboard-break down boxes

Glass bottles (Clear, brown, green or blue)

Aluminum trays & pie plates (unsoiled)

Plastic 1-5 & 7: **(now including butter tubs, yogurt containers, etc., with lids, clamshell deli containers, frozen/ convenience food containers/packaging, plastic pill bottles, all beverage bottles w/lids attached)-rinsed please**

Food boxes (cracker/cookie)

Steel, Aerosol cans

Aluminum and tin cans

Gable-top Milk & OJ cartons

Most Plastics 1-5, 7 & glass bottles *AND lids (attached to bottle)*



Not Recyclable

- Soiled paper or foil
- Soiled paper cups, towels, napkins
- Drinking glasses, dishes
- #6 plastic (styrofoam containers/cups, egg cartons)
- Motor oil containers
- Plastic bags (grocery, bread, dry-clean bags)
- Windows, mirrors
- Toothpaste tubes
- Plastic beverage cups
