### Single-Stream Recycling is Here!



#### Recyclables Include:

Newspapers, Magazines



Paperboard



Corrugated Cardboard



The city of Bloomington is now implementing a single-stream recycling program. What does this mean? It means you are now able to put all recyclables into a single bin. No need to sort! This new system goes into effect on Monday, May 17, 2010.

Blue bins, or recycle bins, are no longer provided by Bloomington. You can, however, purchase a similar bin from your local hardware store or use any other type of bin as long as it is labeled 'recyclables' or 'recycle.' Any bin used, however, may not exceed 33 gallons in volume nor 35 pounds in weight.

Plastic Containers #1,2,3,4,5 & 7 (with some exceptions)



Glass Bottles & Jars (Clear, Blue, Brown, or Green)



#### Non-Recyclables Include:

Plastic #6 (Styrofoam & Plastic Egg Cartons)



Plastic Grocery, Bread, and Dry-Cleaning Bags
